RECOMMENDATION: The City Manager recommends approval of Temp. Reso. R8154 approving the renewal of ShotSpotter Respond Subscription Services from Sound Thinking, Inc. (formerly Shotspotter, Inc.), for a period of three years, from September 30, 2024 to September 29, 2027, in an amount not-to-exceed \$819,000, for the renewal term, and the expenditure of \$74,600 from Law Enforcement Trust Funds towards the renewal in FY25.

<u>ISSUE:</u> Pursuant to Section 2-412(a)(1) of the City Code, approval of the City Commission is required for the purchase or contract for goods or services in excess of \$75,000 from the same vendor in a single fiscal year. City Commission approval is also required to spend funds from the Law Enforcement Trust Fund ("LETF"), in accordance with Florida State Statute 932.7055 and the Guide to Equitable Sharing for State, Local and Tribal Law Enforcement Agencies.

<u>BACKGROUND:</u> On June 16, 2021, the City Commission adopted Resolution No. 21-121, approving the purchase of Gun Shot Detection Technology Services and Equipment from ShotSpotter Inc., (now Sound Thinking, Inc.) for a term of three years. The initial three-year subscription period expires on September 29, 2024, and the Police Department wishes to renew the subscription for another three-year term in order to receive the multi-year discount offered by the Provider.

<u>DISCUSSION:</u> Sound Thinking is an acoustic surveillance technology incorporating audio sensors to detect, locate, and alert police agencies of gunfire incidents in real-time. This technology quickly notifies police of gunshot crimes in progress with real-time data delivered to dispatch centers, patrol cars, and smartphones. It takes approximately one minute from the actual gun discharge to the digital alert to be delivered to the policing

agency, including the precise detection location. Based on increased incidents of shooting and the importance of a quick response, the City sees the value in investing in technology that allows officers to more quickly and efficiently respond to calls related to gunshots and will aid in the investigation of shooting-related cases.

In accordance with Section 2-413 (11)(c) of the City Code, renewal of software licenses and maintenance and licensing agreements to support continued, ongoing use of proprietary software applications are exempt from a competitive procurement process.

ANALYSIS: The City will pay an annual subscription of \$273,000 over the three-year term totaling \$819,000. Upon approval, the FY2025 annual service subscription cost will be funded by the General Fund and the Equitable Sharing Grant Program Treasury as follows: \$198,400 from the Information Technology Account# 001-20-208-529-000-603150, and \$74,600 will be transferred from the Appropriated Fund Balance Account# 160-20-000-521-000-609990-92221 to the Software License & Maintenance Account# 160-20-000-521-000-603425-92221.

term with the option to renew for an additional year not to exceed a 10% increase.
