RE: Temp. Reso. No. 8534, approving the renewal of cybersecurity services and software licenses with vTechio and Peller Technologies

RECOMMENDATION: The City Manager recommends approval of Temp. Reso. No. 8534, for the renewal of cybersecurity services and software licenses with vTechio in an amount of \$267,615 and Peller Technologies in an amount of \$101,400 for FY26.

ISSUE: City Commission approval is required for expenditures exceeding \$75,000 in accordance with City Code Section 2-412(a)(1).

BACKGROUND: Florida Statute 119.0725 provides municipalities with the authority to exempt information critical to cyber infrastructure from public records disclosure to ensure the security of such infrastructure.

The proposed renewal of cybersecurity solutions provides comprehensive cybersecurity services to safeguard the City's computer network against advanced cyber threats. These solutions continuously monitor the network to prioritize and mitigate threats. Using advanced security analytics software allows the IT Department to efficiently identify threats and enhance our security posture.

DISCUSSION: The current services and software license terms expire on December 10, 2025, with vTechio, and December 12, 2025, with Peller Technologies, and must be renewed to maintain coverage and compliance with the City's cybersecurity insurance policy. This resolution will approve the renewal of cybersecurity services and software licenses for a one-year period.

Pursuant to City Code Section 2-413(11)c, renewal of software licenses and maintenance services are exempt from competitive bidding. Below is a breakdown of the proposed renewals:
