RE: Temp. Reso. No. 8615 authorizing the purchase and installation of new audio-visual equipment and professional services to upgrade the Police Department Community Room

RECOMMENDATION: The City Manager recommends approval of Temp Reso. No. 8615, authorizing the purchase and installation of new audio-visual equipment for the Police Department Community Room from Innovate AV, in an amount of \$130,590, through the utilization of The Interlocal Purchasing System (“TIPS”) Cooperative Contract No. 230901, and from Acordis, LLC (“Acordis”), in an amount of \$34,141, through the utilization of the State of Florida Contract # 43220000-NASPO-19-ACS.

ISSUE: City Commission approval is required for expenditures exceeding \$75,000 in accordance with City Code Section 2-412 (a)(1).

BACKGROUND: The Police Department Community Room has had the same audiovisual equipment for more than ten years. An assessment revealed that it no longer meets the space's requirements and needs to be replaced. Furthermore, most of the audiovisual equipment in that room is either non-functional or unusable, rendering the space unsuitable for hosting meetings and other functions.

DISCUSSION: The current equipment is outdated, and new industry-standard technology is necessary. The new equipment will provide greater flexibility and functionality for diverse room use, enhance technical capabilities, and enable connectivity to other meeting spaces at different City facilities. This equipment is urgently needed to make the Police Department Community Room operational. The audiovisual equipment and professional installation services are being purchased from Innovate AV for \$130,590

through TIPS cooperative contract No. 200904, and from Acordis for \$34,141 through State of Florida Contract # 43220000-NASPO.

ANALYSIS: Funding in the amount of \$181,534 has been budgeted in the CIP-Tech Software/Hardware account No. 395-58-800-539-000-606810-54023 (\$138,408), and CIP-Professional Fees, account No. 395-58-800-539-000-606515-54023 (\$40,000), and CIP-Tech Software/Hardware account No. 394-58-800-539-000-606810-54023 (\$3,126).

SCOPE

The scope of work for the Community Room involves a thorough integration of audio-visual systems to provide a seamless multimedia experience. The integration will utilize state-of-the-art equipment to ensure high performance and reliability.

Central to the system will be the Crestron automation components, including the FT2-202-MECH-PTL-B tabletop connection system, which is designed to manage various connectivity requirements efficiently. This will be complemented with Crestron FT2A-CBL-PT-4K-HD and FT2A-CBL-PT-4K-USBC-HD cables to ensure high-definition video and data transmission.

For signal extension, the VigilLink VLEX-U2CT100-TR will be employed to facilitate the transfer of audio and visual signals across long distances without loss of quality. Middle Atlantic's rack systems, such as the CWR-18-26VD and UD3, will ensure organized housing and management of essential hardware.

Power management within the room will be handled by components such as the CRESTRON FT2A-PWR-US-1-BASIC and Middle Atlantic's power products including the PD-915R, ensuring all equipment is protected against power surges. Additionally, backup power will be supported by the CYBERPOWERA OR1500LCDRM1U for uninterrupted operations.

User interface and control will be streamlined with Crestron's TSW-770-B-S touch screen and TS-770-B-S controllers, providing intuitive system control and management. Advanced audiovisual processing and management will be facilitated by the Crestron HD-PS622, supported by the RMC4 control system for seamless operation.

Network and video communication will be optimized using various Windy City Wire products for structured cabling, supporting connectivity needs across the room. Also integrated into the system are a number of video transmitters and receivers from Crestron, such as the HD-RXC-4KZ-101 and HD-TX-4KZ-421-CHGR, to support crisp 4K video transmission.

The audio system design includes Shure products, with the MXA920W-S ceiling array microphone and the QLX-D series of wireless microphone systems, ensuring high-quality sound reinforcement and capture. Amplification and additional audio processing will be handled by the Crestron AMP-X75 and Biamp Systems Tesira FORTE DAN CI, providing robust sound coverage throughout the space.

Additionally, element integration for video conferencing and PTZ camera systems will incorporate PTZ Optics HCM-1-WH cameras, controlled through Sound Control Technologies RC5-CW4.

The Community Room will feature a custom podium setup with an AV LAN connection plate integrated with XLR audio interfaces, to facilitate easy presenter connectivity. Video output will be showcased through the LG Electronics LAPA163-GF.AUSQ displays, offering vibrant visuals for presentations and multimedia content.

Furniture and installation support will be provided by Audio Visual Furniture International and Innovate-AV, while customized installation and training services will be delivered by IAV's comprehensive offering to ensure a smooth implementation and user proficiency in operating the new AV system.

In conclusion, each component and solution has been carefully selected to enhance the functionality and adaptability of the Community Room, ensuring it meets the sophisticated needs of modern multimedia presentations and communications.

Client to provide backing and (2) dedicated 20 amp circuits in the front central display wall.

Client to provide backing from floor to ceiling and the width of the entire display.

The (OFE) installed recessed projection screen shall remain in place but not be incorporated with this new solution. It must also be de-energized by the clients electrical contractor to insure that it can be lowered and damage or impede upon the new display. The (OFE) projector and mount and visible hardware shall be removed.
