A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MIRAMAR, FLORIDA, APPROVING AN EXTENSION AMENDMENT TO THE EMPLOYMENT AGREEMENT BETWEEN ROY L. VIRGIN AND THE CITY OF MIRAMAR FOR A PERIOD OF FIVE YEARS, BEGINNING ON THE DATE THE COMMISSION APPROVES THE AMENDMENT; DIRECTING THE CITY ATTORNEY TO PRESENT THE PROPOSED AMENDED AGREEMENT, INCLUDING ANY FURTHER PROPOSED AMENDMENTS, TO THE CITY COMMISSION AT THE REGULARLY SCHEDULED COMMISSION MEETING ON OCTOBER 15, 2025; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE. (*Commissioner Maxwell Chambers Sponsor*)

WHEREAS, Section 2.05 of the City Charter authorizes the City Commission to appoint a City Manager; and

WHEREAS, the current Employment Agreement between the City and Roy L. Virgin for City Manager Charter duties ("Agreement") expires on May 5, 2027; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Virgin's performance of his duties under the Agreement has been exemplary; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission desires to amend the Agreement to, among other things, extend the term of Mr. Virgin's employment for five (5) years from the date of the Commission's approval of the proposed Amended Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MIRAMAR, FLORIDA:

Section 1. to amend the Agreement to extend the term of Roy L. Virgin's employment and additional five years from the date of the resolution approving the proposed Amended Agreement.

Section 2. The City Attorney and Roy L. Virgin are hereby authorized to present a proposed amended employment agreement for the Commission's consideration at the Commission's regularly scheduled meeting on October 15, 2025.

Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
