for the Pembroke Road from S.W. 160th Avenue to US 27/Miramar Parkway

**Extension Project** 

**RECOMMENDATION:** The City Manager recommends approval of Temp. Reso. No. 8389, commitment to fund Operations and Maintenance for the Pembroke Road from S.W. 160<sup>th</sup> Avenue to US 27/Miramar Parkway Extension Project.

<u>ISSUE:</u> A Resolution from the City Commission confirming commitment to fund the Project's operations and maintenance costs is required.

BACKGROUND: The Pembroke Road from S.W. 160<sup>th</sup> Avenue to US 27/Miramar Parkway Extension Project has been included in the Miramar's Transportation and Mobility Plan (approved by R6559) since April 2018 and is included in the FY2025-FY2029 Adopted Capital Improvement Program (CIP). This project is anticipated to be constructed in three construction segments - the widening of Pembroke Road from S.W. 196<sup>th</sup> Avenue to Dykes Road, expansion of Pembroke Road from US-27 to SW 196<sup>th</sup> Avenue, and extension of Miramar Parkway from S.W. 192<sup>nd</sup> Terrace to Pembroke Road. These roadway improvements will alleviate traffic congestion in western Miramar and provide alternate access to US-27, an important emergency egress route. The City entered into an Interlocal Agreement (ILA) with Broward County for the Project on August 18, 2021, and design is ongoing, with construction anticipated to begin next year. The City must now approve the Resolution, committing to fund the Project's operations and maintenance.

<u>DISCUSSION:</u> The Cities of Miramar and Pembroke Pines will each be responsible to maintain the project elements that fall within their respective rights-of-way after construction is completed. Maintenance responsibilities include cleaning and maintaining

drainage pipes, culverts, outfalls, roadway pavement, sidewalks, shared use paths, noise wall, and swale landscaping and irrigation. Median landscaping and irrigation maintenance will be the responsibility of the City of Miramar from Dykes Road to SW 184<sup>th</sup> Avenue and the City of Pembroke Pines will be responsible for SW 184<sup>th</sup> to US-27 as discussed and concurred with Miramar Public Works Department and the City of Pembroke Pines. Existing drainage culvert maintenance will be the responsibility of the South Broward Drainage District (SBDD). Signals, signing, and pavement markings will be maintained by Broward County Traffic Engineering Division, and components of the lighting system will be maintianed by Florida Power & Light (FPL).

<u>ANALYSIS:</u> These projects are already included in the City's FY 2025-FY2029 Adopted CIP. Staff will include the appropriate operations and maintenance costs in the budget beginning in the fiscal year in which construction ends and maintenance begins.

WHEREAS, construction is anticipated to begin in FY 2026; and

**WHEREAS,** it is the responsibility of City of Miramar to maintain or coordinate the maintenance of the projects after their completion for areas that fall within City right-ofway.

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NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MIRAMAR, FLORIDA AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1</u>: That the foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are made a specific part of this Resolution.

<u>Section 2</u>: That it resolves to fund the operations and maintenance of the Improvements associated with the Project.

<u>Section 3</u>: That the appropriate City Officials are authorized to do all things necessary and expedient to carry out the aims of this Resolution.

**Section 4:** That this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
