Agreement attached hereto as Exhibit "A," and draft Settlement Agreement and Release

(to be finalized and signed by the parties to submit to Judge of Compensation Claims for

approval by Order) as Exhibit "B," and further authorizes the City Manager to take all

necessary action consistent with this Resolution.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon
