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A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MIRAMAR. FLORIDA. SETTLING **BROWARD** COUNTY, FLORIDA CIRCUIT COURT CASE NO. CACE-24-018160; APPROVING PLAT APPLICATION NO. 2404934, SITE PLAN APPLICATION NO. 2402241 AND COMMUNITY APPEARANCE BOARD APPLICATION NO. 2402598 FOR 84-UNIT. MID-RISE AFFORDABLE HOUSING DEVELOPMENT ON THE 2.13 ACRE VACANT PARCEL OF PROPERTY LOCATED AT 3300 FOXCROFT ROAD AND IDENTIFIED BY BROWARD COUNTY PARCEL ID NUMBER 514129010091; PROVIDING FOR CONDITIONS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY: PROVIDING FOR **ADMINISTRATIVE** CORRECTION OF **SCRIVINER'S** ERRORS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, IT Webcam LLC ("Webcam") is the owner of the 2.13 acre vacant parcel of property located at 3300 Foxcroft Road and identified by Broward County Parcel ID Number 514129010091 (the "Property"); and

WHEREAS, on November 14, 2022, the City Commission adopted Resolution No. 23-29, wherein the City Commission allocated 42 bonus affordable housing units to the Property based on its finding that such a facility is "in the best interests of the citizens of Miramar" and will "help expand the supply of affordable housing for the City residents most impacted by the severe multifamily affordable housing shortage that has been plaguing the City"; and

WHEREAS, Arbor Ridge Housing Partners, LP ("Arbor Ridge"), in its capacity as Webcam's authorized agent, seeks to construct an 84-unit mid-rise affordable housing

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development, with related amenities and site improvements (the "Development"), on the Property; and

WHEREAS, Arbor Ridge has submitted Application No. 2404934, a complete application for Plat review, as provided for in Section 307 of the Land Development Code ("LDC"); and

WHEREAS, Arbor Ridge has submitted Application No. 2402241, a complete application for Site Plan review, as further described in the proposed Site Plan appended hereto as Exhibit "B," as provided for in Sections 310 and 311 of the LDC; and

WHEREAS, Arbor Ridge has submitted Application No. 2402598, a complete application for Community Appearance Board ("CAB") review of the proposed Site Plan, as provided for in Section 311 of the LDC; and

WHEREAS, the Development Review Committee ("DRC") has reviewed both Application No. 2404934 and Application No. 2402241, determined that the proposed Site Plan and Plat are in substantial conformance with all of the applicable and published LDC requirements, and thus recommended that the proposed Site Plan and Plat be approved by the City Commission; and

WHEREAS, the CAB has reviewed Application No. 2402598, determined that the proposed Site Plan is in substantial conformance with all of the applicable and published LDC requirements, and thus recommended that the proposed Site Plan be approved by the City Commission; and

WHEREAS, the City's professional planning and engineering staff ("Staff") has reviewed the Development and issued two reports, dated August 14, 2024 and October

10, 2024, both of which recommended that the Development be approved subject to certain conditions; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission reviewed Application No. 2404934, Application No. 2402241, and Application No. 2402598 during quasi-judicial hearings that occurred on September 18, 2024 and October 16, 2024; and

WHEREAS, at the October 16, 2024 hearing, the City Commission voted 5-0 to deny Application No. 2404934, Application No. 2402241, and Application No. 2402598, and the City Commission's decision was subsequently memorialized in an Order dated November 20, 2024 (the "Order"); and

WHEREAS, Arbor Ridge commenced a first-tier certiorari proceeding in Broward County, Florida Circuit Court, Case No. CACE-24-018160 (the "Appeal"), on December 19, 2024; and

WHEREAS, Arbor Ridge and the City attended mediation in the Appeal on August 5, 2025, engaged in a good faith settlement dialogue and, as a result of such dialogue, Arbor Ridge and Webcam have voluntarily agreed to the conditions set forth in Section 4 of this Resolution; and

WHEREAS, the City Attorney and the City Manager recommend that the Appeal be settled and that Application No. 2404934, Application No. 2402241, and Application No. 2402598 be approved by the City Commission subject to the conditions set forth in Section 4 of this Resolution; and

WHEREAS, the City Attorney has reviewed the Deed of Right-of-Way, Easements and Dedications (the "Deed") recorded in Official Records Book 9160 at Page 400 of the Public Records of Broward County, Florida, confirmed that the Deed provides the City

with an easement (the "Access Easement") for the perpetual use of the public, confirmed that Foxcroft Road is located on the Access Easement, confirmed that Foxcroft Road provides ingress to and egress from the Property, and confirmed that Arbor Ridge, Webcam and their successors and/or assigns have the right to access the Property via Foxcroft Road pursuant to the Deed; and

WHEREAS, for illustrative purposes and to eliminate any potential doubt or confusion regarding the portion of Foxcroft Road that provides access to the Property pursuant to the Deed, it is outlined in red and identified as the Access Easement in the picture below:



WHEREAS, Arbor Ridge provided Staff with a traffic study on October 8, 2024 which analyzed the impact of the Development on the intersection of Miramar Parkway and Foxcroft Road, Staff confirmed on October 14, 2024 that no mitigation actions are required, and Staff also confirmed that no other traffic study is required as a condition of approval; and

WHEREAS, Arbor Ridge has complied with the courtesy notice requirements of Section 301.11.1 of the LDC; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission has duly considered the matter and deems it to be in the best interests of the City and its residents to settle the Appeal and approve Application No. 2404934, Application No. 2402241, and Application No. 2402598 subject to the conditions set forth in Section 4 of this Resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MIRAMAR, FLORIDA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Recitals; Definitions:

- (a) The foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are ratified as being true and correct and are made a specific part of this Resolution.
- (b) As used herein, unless the context or City Code of Ordinances requires to the contrary, the following terms will be defined as set forth below:
 - (1) "City" means the City of Miramar, a Florida Municipal Corporation.
 - (2) "Development" is defined as set forth in Section 163.3164, Florida Statutes.
 - (3) "DRC" means the City's Development Review Committee
 - (4) "LDC" means the City's Land Development Code.

- (5) "Plat" means the Plat entitled "Residences at Foxcroft Cove" and appended hereto as Exhibit "A."
- (6) "Site Plan" means the site plan entitled "Residences at Foxcroft Cove" and appended hereto as Exhibit "B."
- (7) "Property" means the 2.13 acre parcel of property located 3300 Foxcroft Road and identified by Broward County Parcel ID Number 514129010091, to wit:

A portion of Everglades Sugar and Land Company Subdivision, according to the map or plat thereof as recorded in Plat Book 3, Page 77, Public Records of Miami-Dade County, Florida, being more particularly described as follows:

Commence at the East 1/4 corner of Section 29, Township 51 South, Range 41 East and run South 01 degrees 49 minutes 49 seconds East along the East line of said Section 29 for 829.93 feet; thence South 88 degrees 10 minutes 11 seconds West at right angles to the last described course for 55.00 feet; thence North 59 degrees 19 minutes 49 seconds West for 830.00 feet; thence North 30 degrees 40 minutes 11 seconds East for 123.45 feet; thence North 16 degrees 26 minutes 49 seconds West for 118.74 feet; thence North 56 degrees 31 minutes 49 seconds West for 145.00 feet to the Point of Beginning of the parcel of land hereinafter described; thence South 74 degrees 04 minutes 11 seconds West for 209.32 feet thence North 01 degrees 49 minutes 49 seconds West for 270.08 feet; thence North 88 degrees 10 minutes 11

seconds East at right angles to the last described course for 430.00 feet; thence South 01 degrees 49 minutes 49 seconds East for 162.07 feet; thence South 74 degrees 04 minutes 11 second West for 234.04 feet to the Point of Beginning.

<u>Section 2:</u> Applications in Substantial Compliance. The City Commission hereby finds:

- (a) The proposed Plat for the Property is in substantial compliance with the requirements of Section 307 of the LDC and thus Application No. 2404934 should be approved.
- (b) The proposed Site Plan for the Property is in substantial compliance with the requirements of Sections 310 and 311 of the LDC and thus Application No. 2402241 and Application No. 2402598 should be approved.

<u>Section 3:</u> Approval of Applications. Subject to the conditions set forth in Section 4 of this Resolution, the City Commission hereby approves:

- (a) Application No. 2404934 (Arbor Ridge's application for Plat review) and the proposed Plat.
- (b) Application No. No. 2402241 (Arbor Ridge's application for Site Plan review) and the proposed Site Plan.
- (c) Application No. 2402598 (Arbor Ridge's application for CAB review) and the proposed Site Plan.

<u>Section 4:</u> Conditions of Approval. The following conditions shall apply to the approvals (the "Approvals") set forth in Section 3 of this Resolution:

- (a) All applicable state and federal permits must be obtained before the commencement of the Development subject to the Approvals.
- (b) Prior to the issuance of a building permit, the Plat shall be recorded in the Public Records of Broward County, Florida.
- (c) Prior to the issuance of a building permit, the submitted plans shall show the size of each unit.
- (d) Prior to the issuance of a building permit, the plans shall indicate that all stormwater must be retained on-site using properly designed seepage or infiltration systems, capable of handling a 5-year storm and fully retaining a 25-year/3-day storm, with pollution control devices at all drainage inlets and off-site drainage improvements meeting applicable corridor design requirements.
- (e) Prior to the issuance of a building permit, a tree removal permit shall be provided to the City for proposed tree removals and relocations.
- (f) Prior to the issuance of a building permit, if applicable, calculations of total caliper inches proposed to be removed and inches proposed to be relocated shall be provided to the City and a mitigation fee shall be paid to the City's Tree Trust Fund accordingly.
- (g) Prior to the issuance of a building permit, tree protection barriers shall be erected.
- (h) Prior to the issuance of a building permit, an appraisal report and value for specimen trees proposed for removal shall be provided to the City.
- (i) Prior to the issuance of a building permit, correct note on landscape plans "for mitigations shortfall shall be paid in the City of Miramar Tree Trust Fund."

- (j) Prior to the issuance of a building permit, engineering shall approve any plantings of proposed trees located within easements.
- (k) Prior to construction, Arbor Ridge shall enter into a Service Agreement for Water and Sanitary Sewage Facilities within the City, which outlines the payment of water and sewer impact fees.
- (I) Prior to construction ERC calculations must be in conformance with the City's latest utility ordinance.
- (m) Prior to the issuance of the final Certificate of Occupancy, no landscaped area shall have any dimension less than five (5) feet with the exception of trees planted in paved areas with the use of a suspended pavement system.
- (n) Prior to the issuance of the final Certificate of Occupancy, Arbor Ridge shall construct the following Crime Prevention Through Environmental Design ("CPTED") features for the Development, such features being more particularly identified in the Site Plan prepared by CFM Architects (latest revision dated July 25, 2024); the Landscape Plan prepared by vdb Landscape Architecture (latest version dated July 23, 2024); and the Photometric Plan prepared by Lighting Dynamics Incorporated (latest version dated July 23, 2024); all of which shall be maintained in perpetuity by the applicable owner of the Property:
 - (i) Natural surveillance features, including windows that overlook the sidewalks and parking lots; well-manicured landscaping to enhance visibility; lighting design that provides abundant illumination in parking lots, pathways, stairs, entrances/exits, hallways, pool, and common areas; and security cameras compatible with the City's Police Department.
 - (ii) Natural access control features, including clearly demarcated public vs. private space; strategically placed identifiable points of entry, lighting and landscaping to limit access; security system signage at access points; key cards or

electronic fobs for building entry; and a fence along the eastern, western, and southern Property lines, which shall be a maximum of six (6) feet in height and reinforced with a landscaped hedge.

(o) Prior to the issuance of the final Certificate of Occupancy, Arbor Ridge shall improve the northern Property line by constructing a concrete sidewalk, installing trees, palms, shrubs and groundcover, removing prohibited tree species, installing lighting fixtures, constructing four parallel parking spaces adjacent to Foxcroft Road, and spreading and compacting a new layer of asphalt pavement on the section of Foxcroft Road that is located on the northern portion of the Property (the "Servient Webcam Property"), such improvements being more particularly identified in the Site Plan prepared by CFM Architects (latest revision dated July 25, 2024); the Landscape Plan prepared by vdb Landscape Architecture (latest version dated July 23, 2024); and the Photometric Plan prepared by Lighting Dynamics Incorporated (latest version dated July 23, 2024). The Servient Webcam Property is depicted in the picture below as the section of Foxcroft Road that is highlighted in yellow and runs east to west:



The section of Foxcroft Road that is highlighted in blue in the picture above is located on private property that is owned by Foxcroft Condominium Apartments, Inc. (the "Servient Condominium Property"). Prior to the issuance of the final Certificate of Occupancy, Arbor Ridge shall spread and compact a new layer of asphalt pavement on the portion of Foxcroft Road that is on the Servient Condominium Property, runs east to west, and is contiguous to the Servient Webcam Property. Arbor Ridge is not required to make any other improvements (including but not limited to removal of the existing pavement, excavation, grading, sub-base installation, drainage, curbing, and stripping) to the portion of Foxcroft Road that is on the Servient Condominium Property, runs east to west, and is contiguous to the Servient Webcam Property. With respect to the remainder of Foxcroft Road that is on the Servient Condominium Property (i.e., the portion that runs north and south and connects to Miramar Parkway), Arbor Ridge shall fill in and otherwise repair

any potholes or other damage caused during construction of the Development, but Arbor Ridge is not required to spread and compact a new layer of asphalt pavement or make any other type of improvements to that portion of Foxcroft Road.

- (p) After the issuance of the final Certificate of Occupancy, Arbor Ridge shall implement the following additional security measures for the Development, all of which shall be provided in perpetuity by the applicable owner of the Property:
 - (i) On-site management and maintenance staff during regular business hours.
 - (ii) Resident selection process that subjects all applicants to background, criminal, and credit checks, employment verification and income qualifications per LIHTC guidelines, and compliance with resident code of conduct.
 - (iii) Restrict private activities to defined private areas.
 - (iv) Regular and timely maintenance to communicate an alert and active presence, including repair of units and interior/exterior common areas, removal of trash/debris, and landscaping upkeep (mowing, trimming, pruning) to enhance the Property and increase visibility.
- (q) If the City receives title to the Servient Condominium Property within two (2) years after the issuance of the final Certificate of Occupancy, then Webcam shall, upon receiving written notice from the City of such transfer of title, pay a total of Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000.00) to the City and these monies shall be used by the City to repair and/or maintain the section of Foxcroft Road that is located on the Servient Condominium Property. However, if the City does not receive title to the Servient Condominium Property within two (2) years after the issuance of the final Certificate of Occupancy, then Webcam's obligation to pay such monies to the City shall automatically terminate.

(r) Upon the adoption of this Resolution, the expiration of all deadlines for filing a judicial proceeding challenging this Resolution and, if such a proceeding is timely filed, a final decision in the proceeding affirming the Approvals in this Resolution, then Arbor Ridge shall dismiss the pending Appeal (i.e., Broward County, Florida Circuit Court, Case No. CACE-24-018160) with prejudice, with Arbor Ridge and the City each bearing their own attorneys' fees and costs in the Appeal.

Section 5: Approvals do not create a Vested Right. The Approvals granted by the City in this Resolution do not in any way create any right on behalf of Arbor Ridge or Webcam to obtain a permit from a state or federal agency and do not create any liability on the part of the City if Arbor Ridge or Webcam fail to obtain the requisite approvals or fulfill the obligations imposed by a state or federal agency or undertake actions that result in a violation of state of federal law.

<u>Section 6:</u> Failure to Adhere to Resolution. Failure to adhere to the terms and conditions contained in this Resolution shall be considered a violation of this Resolution and the City Code, and persons found violating this Resolution shall be subject to the penalties prescribed by the City Code, including but not limited to the revocation of the Approvals granted in this Resolution and any other approvals conditioned on such Approvals. Arbor Ridge understands and acknowledges that it must comply with all other applicable requirements of the City Code before the commencement of construction or operation of the Development, and that the Approvals in this Resolution may be revoked by the City at any time upon a determination that Arbor Ridge is in non-compliance with the City Code.

<u>Section 7:</u> Severability. If any phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, or section of this Resolution be declared unconstitutional by the valid judgment or decree of a court of competent jurisdiction, such unconstitutionality shall not affect any of the remaining portions or applications which shall remain in full force and effect.

<u>Section 8:</u> Administrative Correction of Scrivener's Error. The City Attorney is hereby authorized to correct scrivener's errors in this Resolution by filing a corrected copy with the City Clerk.

<u>Section 9:</u> Effective Date. That this Resolution shall become effective upon adoption (the "Effective Date").

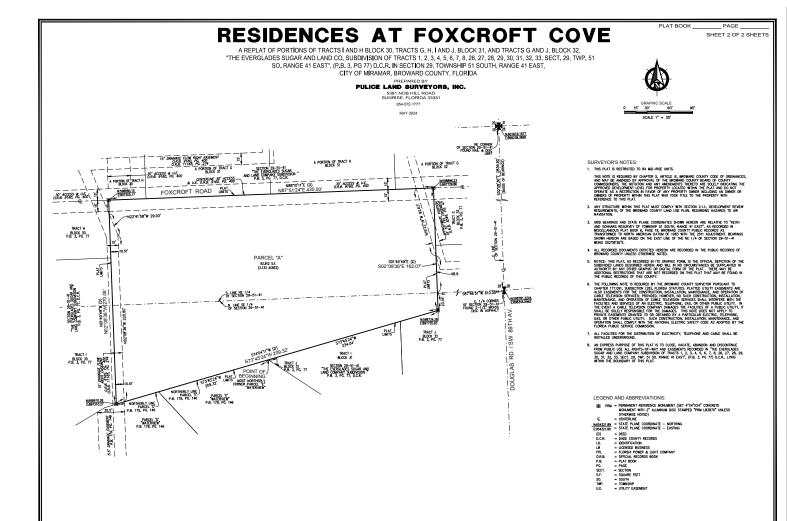
