RE: FIRST READING of Temp. Ord. No. 1792 budget amendment for FY22

RECOMMENDATION: The City Manager recommends approval of Temp. Ord. No. 1792, providing for the second budget amendment of the Fiscal Year 2022 Operating and Capital Improvement Program Budgets.

ISSUE: Pursuant to Section 2-203(a), City Commission approval is required to amend the budget by passage of an ordinance.

BACKGROUND: Per F.S. 166.241(5), the governing body can amend the Fiscal Year 2022 Operating and Capital Improvement Program Budgets only via ordinance.

The City's Procurement Department advertised Invitation for Bid No. 22-008 Historic Miramar Drainage Infrastructure Improvement Project-Phase IV. The lowest responsive responsible bid received by the City totals \$12,907,320.67. This amount excludes allocating a construction allowance of 15 percent and cost for construction management and inspection services. Funds totaling \$13,111,900 are currently available for the project. Due to budget shortfall, additional funds totaling \$3M from the respective fund balances (\$2M from Utilities and \$1M from Stormwater) are being requested to proceed with City Commission award of a construction contract for the project.

DISCUSSION & ANALYSIS: The following items are included in the second Fiscal Year 2022 budget amendment:

<u>Utility Fund (410) – Exhibit A</u>

Revenues (\$2,000,000 adjustment)

• Appropriation of Fund Balance: Increase \$2,000,000 to fund CIP Project.

Expenses (\$2,000,000 adjustment)

• Historic Miramar Drainage Improvements-Phase IV (Project No. 52066). Increase CIP Construction by \$1,600,000 and CIP Contingency by \$400,000 to account for rising costs of materials, equipment, and labor.

• Appropriation of Fund Balance: Increase \$1,000,000 to fund CIP Project.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MIRAMAR, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE SECOND AMENDMENT OF THE FISCAL YEAR 2022 OPERATING AND CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM BUDGET; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, based upon the periodic review and analysis of current budgetary commitments and obligations, the projected needs and requirements of the City and the recommendations of the City Manager, and with the concurrence of the Finance Director as to Accounting Principles, it is deemed necessary to adjust, amend, and implement the Fiscal Year 2022 Operating and Capital Improvement Program Budget; and

WHEREAS, the proposed amendment to the Fiscal Year 2022 Operating and Capital Improvement Program Budget is set forth in Exhibits "A" through "B", attached hereto and made a part hereof; and

WHEREAS, Section 2-203(a) of the City Code provides that "if during the fiscal year, revenues in excess of those estimated in the budget are available for appropriation, the City Commission may make supplemental appropriations for the year up to the amount of such excess"; and

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WHEREAS, this Ordinance will provide funds for additional new projects and unanticipated expenses, as well as for projects that have been previously approved; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager and the Chief Budget Officer recommend approval of this Ordinance, providing funds for additional new projects and unanticipated expenses, as well as for projects that have been previously approved; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission deems it to be in the best interest of the citizens and residents of the City of Miramar to amend to approve the second amendment of the Fiscal Year 2022 operating and capital improvement budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MIRAMAR, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are made a specific part of this Ordinance.

Section 2: That it approves the amendment of the Fiscal Year 2022 Operating and Capital Improvement Program Budget as set forth in Exhibits "A" through "B", attached hereto and made a part hereof.

Section 3: If any clause, section, or other part or application of this Ordinance shall be held by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid,

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such unconstitutional or invalid part or application shall be considered as eliminated and shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions or applications, which shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 4: That the appropriate City officials are authorized to do all things necessary and expedient to carry out the intent and purpose of this Ordinance.

<u>Section 5</u>: That this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its adoption on second reading.


