TO PREPARE AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A
RETIREMENT SYSTEM FOR ELECTED OFFICIALS OF
THE CITY OF MIRAMAR THAT HAVE SERVED A
MINIMUM OF EIGHT YEARS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN
EFFECTIVE DATE.**

WHEREAS, public service is a noble calling which requires dedication from the
City's elected officials; and

WHEREAS, the ability of the City of Miramar to be responsive, innovative, and
effective depends on vision and dedication of its elected officials; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE
CITY OF MIRAMAR, FLORIDA AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1: That the foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are ratified and confirmed as
being true and correct and are made a specific part of this Resolution.

Section 2: That the City Attorney is directed to prepare an ordinance establishing
a retirement system for elected officials of the City of Miramar that have served a minimum
of eight (8) years for first reading at the Commission's regularly scheduled meeting on
November 2, 2022.

Section 3: That the appropriate City officials are authorized to do all things
necessary and expedient to carry out the aims of this Resolution.

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Section 4: That this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
