<u>RECOMMENDATION:</u> The City Manager recommends approval of Temp. Reso. No. 6978, supporting the Broward Metropolitan Planning Organization's ("MPO") 2045 Metropolitan Transportation Plan cost feasible project for Southwest 148th Avenue (the "Project").

ISSUE: The Broward MPO has requested that the City adopt a Resolution of support for the proposed Project.

BACKGROUND: In December 2017, the MPO began the process of updating its long term transportation plan known as the Commitment 2045 Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP; formerly the Long Range Transportation Plan). The MTP has been developed through coordinating committees and the MPO board, and includes projected future revenues from funding sources for allocation to projects. Through that process, a "cost feasible" group of projects was identified, which was approved by the MPO Board on May 9, 2019. The following proposed Project is included in the cost feasible group:

Before moving forward with the future programming of this project, the City must provide support through a City Resolution. The Project will be funded by the MPO and design/construction management will be provided by the Florida Department of Transportation. The Project's timeline for implementation is between 2036 and 2045.

<u>COMPREHENSIVE PLAN ELEMENT:</u> The proposed project is consistent with the following sections of the Transportation Element:

The City of Miramar shall coordinate the transportation system with other entities, transportation plans and programs.

Transportation Improvement Program; and

within the City's rights-of-way; and

WHEREAS, it is the responsibility of the City to maintain or coordinate the

maintenance of the roadways after the Project is completed; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager recommends that the City Commission express its

support for the proposed project in Exhibit "A"; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission deems it to be in the best interest of the citizens

and residents of the City of Miramar to support the proposed Project in Exhibit "A".

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
