**RE:** Temp. Reso. No. 7003, supporting applications for funding from the Broward Metropolitan Planning Organization 2019 Complete Streets and Localized Initiatives Program for projects on Honey Hill Road and SW 184<sup>th</sup> Avenue

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**RECOMMENDATION:** The City Manager recommends approval of Temp. Reso. No. 7003, supporting applications for funding from the Broward Metropolitan Planning Organization ("MPO") 2019 Complete Streets and Localized Initiatives Program ("CSLIP") for projects on Honey Hill Road and SW 184<sup>th</sup> Avenue.

**ISSUE:** The Broward MPO has requested that the City adopt a resolution expressing support for the proposed projects for which the City will request funding from the 2019 CSLIP.

**BACKGROUND:** The City seeks to submit applications for funding from the Broward MPO 2019 CSLIP for the following Projects:

1. Honey Hill Road Complete Streets Project (Flamingo Road to Red Road): construction of 8-foot wide shared asphalt path for bicycles and pedestrians and pedestrian lighting.
2. SW 184<sup>th</sup> Avenue Complete Streets Project: widening of the asphalt shoulder on 184<sup>th</sup> (Miramar Parkway to Pembroke Road) to accommodate 7-foot wide buffered bike lanes and pedestrian lighting on the west side. In addition, widen the existing sidewalk on the south side of Pembroke Road (SW 184<sup>th</sup> Av. to SW 172<sup>nd</sup> Av.) for a 10-foot wide shared path for bicycles and pedestrians and pedestrian lighting.

The improvements are more particularly described in Exhibit "A" of the resolution and the locations are shown on Attachments 1 and 2. These projects will continue ongoing efforts for complete streets improvements throughout the the city, including neighborhoods in Historic Miramar between SW 62<sup>nd</sup> Avenue and State Road 7, SW 62<sup>nd</sup> Avenue and Miramar Parkway between SW 64<sup>th</sup> Avenue and SW 68<sup>th</sup> Avenue. This Resolution seeks support for submitting applications for enhancement of pedestrian/bike pathways and pedestrian lights along Honey Hill Road and SW 184<sup>th</sup> Avenue. If approved, these projects would be funded by the MPO and the design and construction would be completed by the Florida Department of Transportation.

**COMPREHENSIVE PLAN ELEMENT:** The proposed project is consistent with the following sections of the Transportation Element:

### **Coordinate Transportation Plans and Programs**

#### **Objective 2**

The City of Miramar shall coordinate the transportation system with other entities, transportation plans and programs.

### **Convenience**

#### **Policy 5.5.1.**

Through its membership in the MPO, continue to maintain and improve the bikeways/pedestrian ways network through inclusion of bikeways and pedestrian ways in road construction projects and through greenways.

**WHEREAS**, the City of Miramar supports the completion of sidewalk networks along the City's rights-of-way to provide connectivity and safe pedestrian pathways; and

**WHEREAS**, the City seeks to submit applications for funding from the Broward Metropolitan Planning Organization ("MPO") 2019 Complete Streets and Localized Initiatives Program ("CSLIP") for projects on Honey Hill Road and SW 184<sup>th</sup> Avenue, attached hereto as Exhibit "A"; and

**WHEREAS**, the MPO has requested that the city adopt a resolution expressing support for the projects listed in Exhibit "A," and committing to fund the maintenance of the improvements to be constructed within Miramar's rights-of-way; and

**WHEREAS**, the City supports the submission of the applications through the MPO 2019 CSLIP for the projects listed in Exhibit "A," and commits to fund the maintenance of the improvements to be constructed within Miramar's rights-of-way; and

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**WHEREAS**, the design and construction of the projects, if approved by the MPO, will be performed by the Florida Department of Transportation (“FDOT”), and funding for the projects will be provided by the MPO; and

**WHEREAS**, the City must approve of FDOT’s delivery of the projects that fall within the City’s jurisdictional rights-of-way; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Manager recommends that the City express its support for the projects listed in Exhibit “A”, commit to fund the maintenance of the improvements to be constructed within Miramar’s rights-of-way, and approve FDOT to deliver the projects within the City’s rights-of-way; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Commission deems it to be in the best interest of the citizens and residents of the city to express its support for the projects listed in Exhibit “A,” commit to fund the maintenance of the improvements to be constructed within Miramar’s rights-of-way, and approve FDOT to deliver the projects within the city’s rights-of-way.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF MIRAMAR, FLORIDA AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1:** That the foregoing “**WHEREAS**” clauses are ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are made a specific part of this Resolution.

**Section 2:** That the City supports the projects listed in Exhibit “A” and commits to fund the maintenance of the improvements to be constructed within Miramar’s rights-of-way.

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**Section 3:** That the City approves FDOT to deliver the projects within the City's rights-of-way.

**Section 4:** That the appropriate City Officials are authorized to do all things necessary and expedient to carry out the aims of this resolution.

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**Section 5:** That this Resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.

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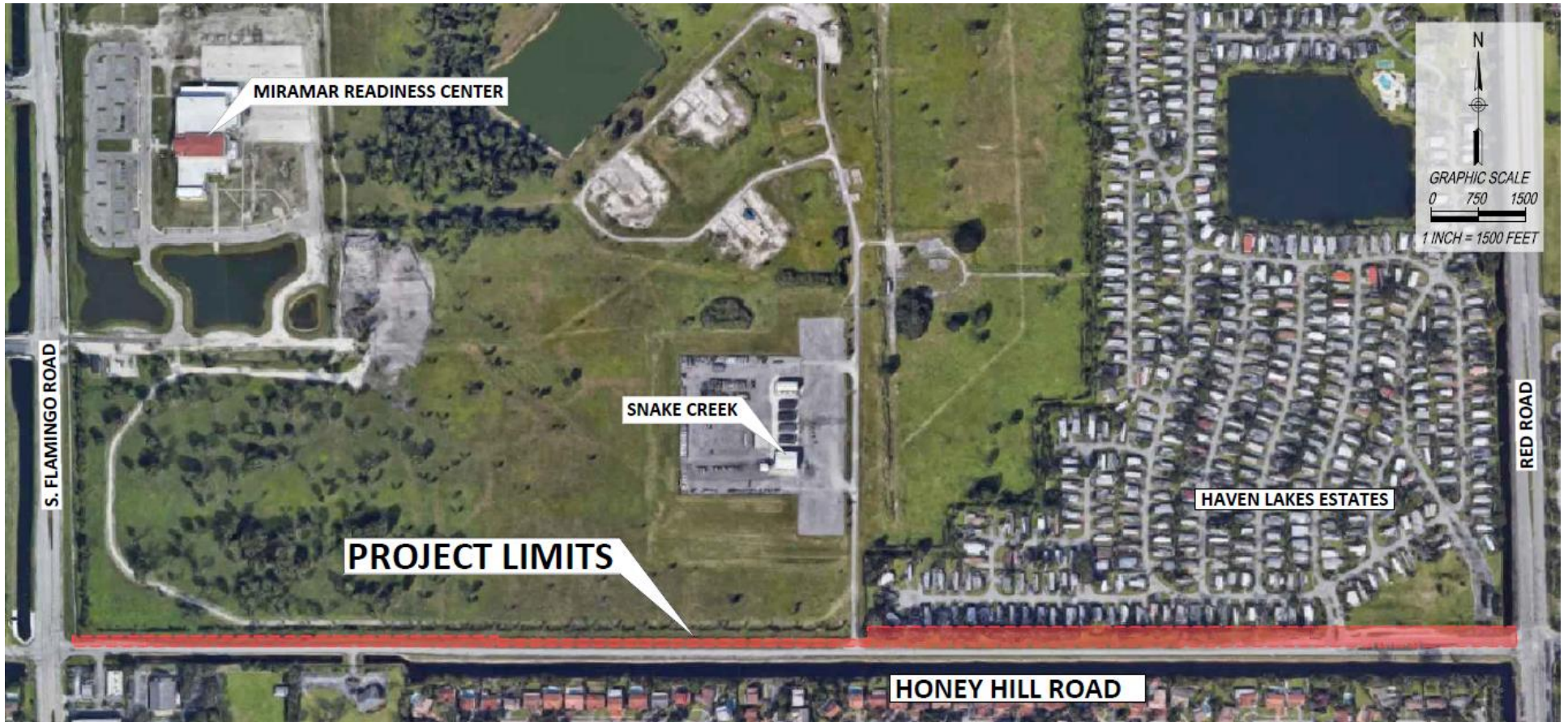
## EXHIBIT “A”

### Priority List of Projects for “2019 Complete Streets/Localized Initiatives Program” Application

PRIORITY	PROJECT DESCRIPTION
1	<b>Honey Hill Road Mobility and Pedestrian Safety Improvements:</b> Construction of eight (8) feet wide shared asphalt path for bicycles & pedestrians, and installation of pedestrian light poles between Flamingo Road and Red Road. Also, construct a Mobility Hub for students to ride the school bus.
2	<b>SW 184<sup>th</sup> Avenue and Pembroke Road Mobility and Pedestrian Safety Improvements:</b> Widening of the asphalt shoulder along SW 184 <sup>th</sup> Avenue (from Miramar Parkway to Pembroke Road) to accommodate seven (7) feet buffered bike lanes on both sides of the roadway and installation of pedestrian light poles along the back end of the existing sidewalk on the west side of SW 184 <sup>th</sup> Avenue. In addition, the project include the widening of the existing concrete sidewalk along south side of Pembroke Road (from SW 184 Avenue to SW 172 Avenue) to make a 10 feet wide shared path for bicycles and pedestrians and installation of pedestrian light poles along this corridor.
