**RECOMMENDATION:** The City Manager recommends approval of Temp. Ord. No. 1734, providing for the first budget amendment of the Fiscal Year 2020 Operating and Capital Improvement Program Budgets.

**ISSUE:** Pursuant to Section 2-203(a), City Commission approval is required to amend the budget.

**BACKGROUND:** The following items are included in the first Fiscal Year 2020 budget amendment:

# General Fund (001) - Exhibit A

# Expenses (\$0 adjustment)

- Public Works: Decrease \$423,150 as a result of transferring landscape services costs from Public Works to Parks & Recreation – Parks Maintenance Program - to cover the contractual cost for the maintenance of certain parks.
- Parks & Recreation: Increase \$423,150 as a result of transferring landscape services costs from Public Works to Parks & Recreation – Parks Maintenance Program - to cover the contractual cost for the maintenance of certain parks.

#### Economic Development Fund (006) – Exhibit B

#### Revenues (\$94,714 adjustment)

 Appropriation of Fund Balance: Increase \$94,714 to appropriate half (1/2) the funds from the renewal and of the Amended and Restated Solid Waste and Recycling Collection Franchise Agreement with Waste Pro (Reso.
