RE: Temp. Reso. No. R7392, supporting the conversion of projects FM # 448290-1 from the Broward Metropolitan Planning Organization ("MPO") Complete Streets and Localized Initiatives Program ("CSLIP") to be delivered through the Local Agency Program ("LAP")

RECOMMENDATION: The City Manager recommends approval of Temp. Reso. No. R7392, supporting the conversion of project FM # 448290-1 from the Broward Metropolitan Planning Organization ("MPO") Complete Streets and Localized Initiatives Program ("CSLIP") to be delivered through the Local Agency Program ("LAP").

ISSUE: The Broward MPO has requested that the City adopt a new resolution of support converting projects included in the FDOT 5 Year Work Program to be delivered through LAP.

BACKGROUND: The City was ranked and vetted to receive funds from the Broward MPO's CSLIP for the following Project:

1. Honey Hill Drive from Flamingo Road to Red Road

The improvements are more particularly described in Exhibit "A" of the Resolution and the location is shown on Attachment 1. The City Commission previously approved Resolutions 19-163 and 20-126 supporting application for the project.

DISCUSSION: At a recent MPO workshop on CSLIP, MPO staff informed attendees from various municipalities that moving forward all CSLIP projects will be administered via the LAP initiative; and a new resolution to convert to LAP was needed to move forward with the projects and programming of funds by FDOT. This Resolution, therefore, supersedes the funding structure and delivery system outlined in Resolutions 19-163 and 20-126.

Previously the MPO provided full funding upfront to cover the cost of construction, design, construction engineering, and inspection ("CEI") services. Projects were also fully administered by the Florida Department of Transportation. The CSLIP program is now being transitioned to LAP and Municipalities will now be responsible for providing project management services and upfront costs for CEI services.

<u>ANALYSIS:</u> MPO and FDOT will reimburse costs for design, construction and CEI services on a determined frequency, typically quarterly, and starting on the fiscal year that the funding is programmed in the FDOT 5-year program. The City is responsible to cover any construction contingencies.

Current estimates show the following anticipated costs:

<u>FY 25</u>

• Design - \$296,677

<u>FY 27</u>

- CEI \$110,194
- Construction \$847,650
- Contingency \$84,765

All costs are fully reimbursable excluding contingency. The City will need to budget accordingly for these upfront costs.

WHEREAS, this Resolution supersedes the funding structure and delivery system outlined in Resolutions 19-163 and 20-126; and
