All costs are reimbursable except for contingencies in the amount of \$399,610.

No. R7393, supporting the conversion of complete streets improvement projects along Miramar Parkway from SW 172nd Ave to Dykes Road, included in the Broward Metropolitan Planning Organization's ("MPO") Complete Streets Master Plan ("CSMP"), to be delivered through the Local Agency Program ("LAP")

RECOMMENDATION: The City Manager recommends approval of Temp. Reso. No. R7393, supporting the conversion of complete streets improvement project along Miramar Parkway from SW 172nd Ave to Dykes Road, included in the Broward Metropolitan Planning Organization's ("MPO") Complete Streets Master Plan ("CSMP"), to be delivered through the Local Agency Program ("LAP").

ISSUE: The Broward MPO has requested that the City adopt a new resolution of support converting projects that are funded through the CSMP to be delivered through LAP.

BACKGROUND: The Broward MPO adopted a Complete Streets Master Plan (CSMP) on February 14, 2019. The CSMP identifies proposed projects to be programmed for future funding by the MPO. The following project within Miramar is expected to be programmed for funding:

**Bike lanes, pedestrian paths, furnishing zones, etc.

DISCUSSION: The City Commission previously approved Resolution 19-130 supporting this project. At a recent MPO Workshop, MPO staff informed attendees from various municipalities that moving forward all projects will be administered through the LAP initiative. This resolution, therefore, supersedes the funding structure and delivery system outlined in Resolution 19-130.

Previously the MPO provided full funding upfront to cover the cost of construction, design and Construction Engineering and Inspection ("CEI") services. Projects were also fully administered by the Florida Department of Transportation. The CSMP program is now being transitioned to LAP and Municipalities will now be responsible for providing project management services and upfront costs for design, CEI services.

ANALYSIS: MPO and FDOT will reimburse costs for design, construction and CEI on a determined frequency, typically quarterly, and starting on the fiscal year that the funding is programmed in the FDOT 5-year program. The City is responsible to cover any construction contingencies.

Project funding is not yet programmed but the following costs are anticipated:

• Design - \$679,337

<u>FY 27</u>

- CEI \$559,454
- Construction \$3,996,100
- Contingency \$399,610

All costs are fully reimbursable excluding contingency. The City will need to budget accordingly for these upfront costs.

WHEREAS, the project listed in Exhibit "A" (the "Project") has been identified as a

high-ranking project in the CSMP's list of recommendations; and

WHEREAS, a resolution from the City of Miramar Commission stating support for

the Project is required by the MPO to establish funding eligibility; and

WHEREAS, federally funded projects off the state highway system are delivered

using the federally mandated Local Agency Program (LAP) process; and

WHEREAS, the LAP program is reimbursement based as specified in the LAP agreement; and

WHEREAS, the City of Miramar commits to administer the project along Miramar Parkway listed in Exhibit "A" under the Local Agency Program ("LAP") when the project is deemed eligible for funding; and

WHEREAS, the City of Miramar will have to commit to fund the upfront costs for design, Construction Engineering and Inspection ("CEI") services, and construction to be then reimbursed per the requirements of LAP before the project along Miramar Parkway listed in Exhibit "A" is programmed for funding; and

WHEREAS, the City of Miramar will have to commit to program funding for construction contingency per the requirements of LAP before the project along Miramar Parkway listed in Exhibit "A" is programmed for funding; and

WHEREAS, the project along Miramar Parkway listed in Exhibit "A" will be constructed within the City's right of way; and

WHEREAS, it is the responsibility of City of Miramar to maintain or coordinate the maintenance of the roadways after the completion of the project; and

WHEREAS, the City previously approved Resolution 19-130 expressing support for the project listed in Exhibit "A"; and

WHEREAS, this Resolution supersedes the funding structure and delivery system outlined in Resolution 19-130; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager recommends that the City Commission continue to support and approve the conversion of the project listed in Exhibit "A" to be delivered through LAP.

<u>Section 3:</u> That the City will have to commit to upfront costs for design, CEI services, and construction to be reimbursed per the requirements of LAP before the project along Miramar Parkway listed in Exhibit "A" is programmed for funding.

Section 4: That the City commits to program funding for construction contingencies per the requirements of LAP for the project along Miramar Parkway listed in Exhibit "A".

Section 5: That the appropriate City Officials are authorized to do all things necessary and expedient to carry out the aims of this Resolution.

Section 6: That this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.


