acting as Lead Agency and administering complete streets improvement projects along Pembroke Road from SW 145th Ave to Douglas Road, as included in the Broward Metropolitan Planning Organization's ("MPO") Complete Streets Master Plan ("CSMP"), to be delivered through the Local

Agency Program ("LAP")

RECOMMENDATION: The City Manager recommends approval of Temp. Reso. No. R7452, expressing support for the City of Pembroke Pines acting as Lead Agency and administering complete streets improvement projects along Pembroke Road from SW 145th Ave to Douglas Road, as included in the Broward Metropolitan Planning Organization's ("MPO") Complete Streets Master Plan ("CSMP"), to be delivered through the Local Agency Program ("LAP").

ISSUE: The Broward MPO has requested that the City of Miramar provide a resolution expressing support for the City of Pembroke Pines acting as Lead Agency and administering projects that are funded through the CSMP to be delivered through LAP.

BACKGROUND: The Broward MPO adopted a CSMP on February 14, 2019. The CSMP identifies proposed projects to be programmed for future funding by the MPO. The following projects within the Cities of Miramar and Pembroke Pines are expected to be programmed for funding:

<u>DISCUSSION:</u> The City of Miramar Commission previously approved Resolution 19-130 supporting both projects. At a recent MPO workshop, MPO staff informed attendees from various municipalities that moving forward all Projects will be administered through the LAP initiative.

The City of Pembroke Pines and the City of Miramar share Pembroke Road as a portion of each city's border. The Projects will directly serve both municipal populations by improving the safety and mobility for all transportation users. The City of Pembroke Pines has agreed by resolution to act as the Lead Agency, as well as to administer and deliver both projects through the LAP.

ANALYSIS: Previously the MPO provided full funding upfront to cover the cost of construction, design and Construction Engineering and Inspection ("CEI") services. Projects were also fully administered by the Florida Department of Transportation. The CSMP program is now being transitioned to LAP and Municipalities will now be responsible for providing project management services and upfront costs for design, construction and CEI.

Via resolution, the City of Pembroke Pines committed to funding upfront costs for design, CEI, construction and construction contingency to be then reimbursed pursuant to the requirements of LAP before the projects are programmed for funding.

The City of Miramar therefore needs to provide a resolution expressing support for the City of Pembroke Pines acting as Lead Agency and administering projects that are funded through the CSMP to be delivered through LAP.


